BIBLE PASSAGE

2 Chronicles 24:1-14

LIFE POINT

The church gives offerings to support the work of God.

CHRIST FOCUS

Jesus gave His life as an offering for sin and forgiveness.

LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING

In addition to money, offerings can include time, talents, and possessions.

BIBLE VERSE

⁸Give thanks to the Lord; call on his name; proclaim his deeds among the peoples. ⁹Sing to him; sing praise to him; tell about all his wondrous works!

YOUR ROLE

- To support the KidsTime Leader in the lesson, games, and activities by:
- Modeling participation
- Redirecting attention
- Taking a count of all present (use red box)
- Using behavior system (strikes on sticker)
- Overseeing bathroom/drink breaks
- Facilitating **CheckOut Procedure**

RULES

Respect: God, Leaders, and Other

BEHAVIOR SYSTEM

- Check-in tags have 3 numbers across the bottom for “3 Strikes”
- After a child has been SPECIFICALLY warned and a behavior continues, remove a corner of their sticker
- Example: Warning: “When you push your friend, you are not showing them respect. Please do not push your friends.”*
- Strike 1&2: “Because you chose to push your friend again, I am taking a strike. Please do not push your friends.”*
- Strike 3: “Because you are still pushing your friends, you will have to speak to Pastor Daniel about your choices.”*
- Be sure to inform the leader when and why a strike was taken.
- On the 3rd strike, send them to me for parent contact.

BATHROOM BREAKS

- Children are allowed bathroom breaks as needed
- Using best judgment, discourage drink breaks except after active games
- Follow child to front foyer, but avoid entering bathroom
- Using best judgment, avoid repeat trips
- Ensure child rejoins the group promptly
